

Fig. 1 - Install the brake lever onto the handlebar and depress the lever arm to access the internal mounting bolt.






Fig. 2a cable anchor cable housing

Verify that the cable housing has been fully inserted and properly seated against the internal recess.

Fig. 3 - Secure the cable housing to the handlebar with electrical tape or a similar material.



3a - Wrap the handlebars with grip tape and install/adjust the brake caliper per the manufacturer's instructions.

Fig. 4a - For normal riding, press the cable QR pin fully towards the handlebar




Fig. 4b - To reduce cable tension on the brake caliper for wheel removal, etc., press the cable QR pin fully AWAY from the handlebar stem.





Fig. 5 - To maintain the smooth operation and reduce noise during brake lever operation, periodically lubricate the cable anchor pivots.
